OPTOMAP® RETINAL EXAM

The **optomap®** provides the doctor with a digital, wide field of view of your retina so both you and the doctor can view your retina on a computer screen. This creates a permanent record of your retina. Retinal imaging is an important tool for the screening and diagnosis of eye problems, such as retinal detachment, glaucoma, retinal holes or tears and macular degeneration. It can also indicate evidence of systemic diseases, such as diabetes, hypertension and certain cancers. The **optomap®** retinal exam captures a 200 internal degree view of the retina and does not require pupil dilation unless certain ocular conditions or patient medical history indicates the need. Because this new technology is considered an advanced screening, it is not paid for by vision insurance plans. Dr. Szeliga recommends that every patient, regardless of age, gets the **optomap®** retinal exam annually.

PROGRESSIVE MULTIFOCAL LENSES

Sometimes referred to as no-line bifocals, they not only provide visual correction for distances that bifocals cannot, but they also hide the fact that you even need reading glasses.

Because no two patients are ever alike – they are specifically made to order according to your prescription and with precise measurements of how your frame fits your face. For the ultimate in visual performance, these premium individualized progressive lenses offer the smoothest progression from near to far and the widest reading and intermediate zones.

TEFLON® ANTI-REFLECTIVE CLEAR COAT LENSES

This lens coating eliminates reflections to provide clearer and crisper vision than ordinary lenses. They improve night vision and relieve indoor glare. By allowing others to see through to your eyes rather than reflections, they are also cosmetically more appealing. We recommend anti-reflective coating to those who: drive at night, dawn, or dusk; use a computer; work under fluorescent lights; play video games; watch TV; and read with overhead or window lighting.

COMPUTER LENSES / TASK SPECIFIC LENSES

These lenses are prescribed especially for the work or specialty task you are involved with directly in front of you. They provide wider, more comfortable vision in that specific range versus ordinary one-distance readers.

POLARIZED LENSES

These sun lenses eliminate glare from water, roadways, snow and any shiny, reflective surfaces like dashboards. These lenses are the ultimate in true outdoor performance while driving or when involved in water activities.

NON-PRESCRIPTION SUNGLASSES

Excellent over contact lenses or for anyone who does not require a prescription, these lenses are available in many colors to enhance your sport or special outdoor activity. These lenses will absorb 100% of the harmful ultraviolet rays that age and damage the soft tissues in and around the eyes.

TRANSITIONS® PHOTOCROMIC LENSES

Clear indoors and sunglass-dark outdoors, these lenses provide convenient protection from UV radiation and glare. They are an alternative to clear lenses and are not designed to replace your driving sunglasses.



SUNCLIPSTM: CLIP ON SUNWEAR

Turn virtually any style frame into a pair of sunglasses. SunClips are: polarized, rimless, lightweight, and made of shatter-resistant polycarbonate lenses. They have a scratch coat and back surface anti-reflective coating to reduce glare.

THINNER / LIGHTER HIGH INDEX AND ASPHERIC LENSES

These lenses are designed for stronger prescriptions. They are thinner and lighter than average lenses with a less magnified look. Ask to see a sample comparison.

POLYCARBONATE LENSES

These lenses are designed for ultra-impact resistance. They are required for all safety wear, impact sports, and all children's eyewear. They are thinner and lighter than ordinary plastic lenses, block UV radiation, and have a front surface scratch coat.

SAFETY GLASSES

More than 90% of all eye injuries can be prevented with use of appropriate protective eyewear. Available in prescription and non-prescription, a safety frame must have the ANSI Z87.1 logo and the lenses must be made of at least 3 mm thick shatter-resistant polycarbonate.

SPORTS EYEWEAR

Sports participants using "street wear" eyeglasses are at a far greater risk of severe eye injuries than participants using no eye protection. Available in prescription and non-prescription, sports eyewear must meet the ASTM Standard F803 and lenses must be made of at least 3 mm thick shatter-resistant polycarbonate.

CONTACT LENSES:
